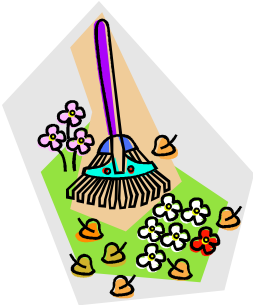
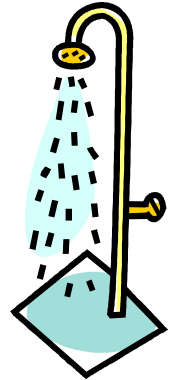
Gull's President, Thea Melton

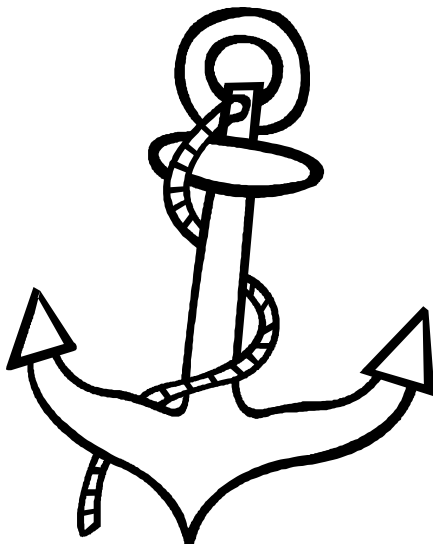


