In closing Terry and I wish all of our Eastern Yacht Club family a very happy holiday season and New Year full of good health, fellowship and many wonderful memories.

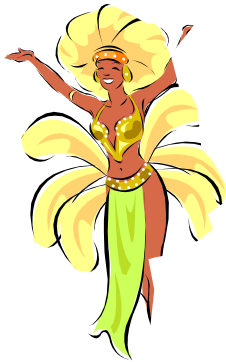

Dear Eastern Yacht Club Members:

Notice is hereby given of a proposed change to the current by-laws of EYC. These changes pertain to Article VI Membership, Section 1, Paragraph (d) and the addition of Paragraph (f). The change to paragraph (d) will require that as of the effective date of the change individuals who are seeking to become new members of EYC will not be eligible to buy out of work duty until they have completed a minimum of 5 years of service. The addition of paragraph (f) adds language to the by-laws to create a Gold Membership Status which excuses long term club members from required work duties.

Current By-Law Language - Article VI Membership, Section 1, Paragraph (d)

(d) Regular Membership Class C: - A regular member must be a participating member who shall be required to pay all dues, assessments and fees as may be required by the rules and by-laws of EYC. Said member shall also pay an annual fee at time of payment of dues in the amount of \$450.00 to be excused from the regular assignment of duties as outlined for a regular member in paragraph (b).

Proposed By-Law Language - Article VI Membership, Section 1, Paragraph (d)

(d) Regular Membership Class C: - A regular member must be a participating member who shall be required to pay all dues, assessments and fees as may be required by the rules and by-laws of EYC. Said member shall also pay an annual fee at time of payment of dues in the amount of \$450.00 to be excused from the regular assignment of duties as outlined for a regular member in paragraph (b). A new member will not be eligible to buy out of work duty until they have been a member in good standing of EYC for a minimum of 5 years.

Current By-Law Language - Article VI Membership, Section 1, Paragraph (f)

No paragraph (f) currently exists in the EYC by-laws.

Proposed By-Law Language - Article VI Membership, Section 1, Paragraph (f)

(f) Gold Member: - Gold membership status will be awarded for appreciation to a participating member in good standing who has provided at least 10 years of continuous service to EYC, if the years of service combined with the members age totals 90 or greater they will be excused from work duty as described in paragraph (b).
