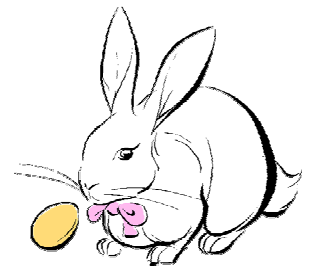

The theme for 2009 is "New York City"

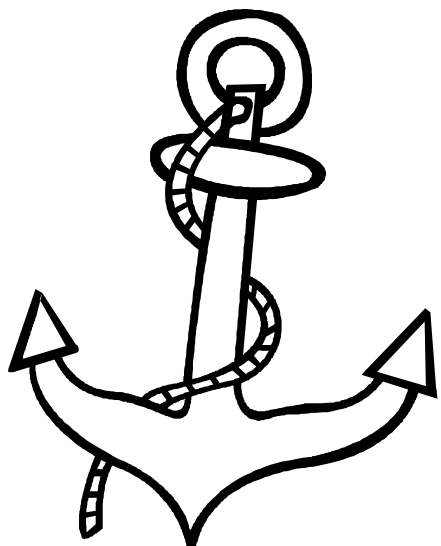
The 3 C's entertainment officer in charge of the Ball will begin to accept checks in payment for room reservations on April 1st 2008.
